AIR SHOW IN ROCK SPRINGS SUNDAY PLENTY OF THRILLS

Former Royal Canadian Air Force Flight Lt Dick Sekman famous stunt man from Miami Fla will be seen in action at the Wyoming State Air Show which will be held at the Thomas Berta Airport in Rock Springs Sunday May 27

The Junior Chamber of Commerce sponsors of the event announced this week that Sekman will perform without a safety device of any kind a sensational trapeze act on a ladder suspended below a flying airplane within a few feet of the ground It is a thrilling and exciting act but to this daredevil stunt man it is just routine

Sekman also will make a sensational delayed parachute jump He leaves the airplane at 5000 feet and opens his parachute until he is within a few feet of the ground

The show starts at 2:30 p m and the gates will be open at 10 a m Most ticket sellers will be on hand so spectators can enter without delay

The many trails followed by the trappers are marked by scenes of hardship peril and death The fur trade offered a challenge to the brave the daring and the adventurous Get acquainted with some of these guys at the Rendezvous like Jim Bridger for instance

When he was only ten years old Jim Bridger operated a flatboat ferry at St Louis, and supported himself and sister and at Soon after this he went on his first expedition into the mountains, and displayed great qualities as a natural leader. He was cool headed, daring, resourceful beyond his years. His ability and judgment won respect of all members of the expedition.

COUNTY AGENT NEWS

IF YOU WANT EVERGREENS IN YOUR YARD READ THIS ADVICE FROM AN EXPERT

Never prune evergreens when planting warns W O Edmondson forester and horticulturist of the Wyoming Agricultural Extension service He means that the tops and side branches should not be cut off although broken branches and roots may be cut off with a sharp knife

Broken branches and broken roots of broadleafed trees should be trimmed off at planting time If the tops are long and bushy the top branches can be headed back too because these trees generally start to grow better if the root system doesn't have to support too many branches at first

Evergreen do not require pruning at any time as they grow he continues

Broadleaved trees may develop five or six main branches at the ground the first year or two and these branches may be pressed down on the ground by snow so it is well to prune the side branches coming from the base

Leave one or two main branches to grow straight and tall Trim the branches close to the main stem not leaving stubs and stumps

PLANS SHAPING UP FOR 4 H STATE TRAINING CAMP

At least 150 4 H junior leaders and members will move into the State Fair grounds at Douglas June 11 through 15 to participate in the annual 4 H junior leaders and conservation training camp

Four full days and five evenings of special training are on the program which will include outstanding speakers discloses Burton W Marston 4 H club leader of the Wyoming Agricultural Extension service

The main purpose of the camp will be to provide training to two groups of 4 H Club members—one of junior leaders who will be trained in their jobs as junior leaders of 4 H clubs and the other group consisting of general club members in the broad field of conservation All delegates will receive training in health recreation and handicraft activities

A delegation of not over 10 4 H members—six junior leaders and four conservation delegates, plus chaperones may attend from each county Junior leaders must be 16 years of age or older by the end of July and conservation delegates 14 or over by the same date

Sponsors who are contributing funds to the camp are the Wyoming Bankers association the Sears Roebuck Foundation the U S Rubber company and the Federal Cartridge corporation

Members of the staff in charge will be drawn from the University the State Department of Health, the State Game and Fish department the U S Forest service and the U S Soil conservation service

A junior committee of nine members elected at last year's camp helped in program planning Marston said These 4 H'ers are Albert Grable of Boulder chairman Donald Kaufmann of Ucross and Dorothy Gibbs of Newcastle, northeast
