The Law of Newspapers.

The following are some of the provisions of a General Newspaper Law, passed by Congress. We hope our subscribers will not fail to carefully read them.

Subscribers who do not give express notice to the contrary, are considered as wishing to continue their subscription.

If subscribers order the discontinuance of their periodicals, the publishers will continue to send them till all arrears are paid.

If subscribers neglect or refuse to take their periodicals from the office to which they are directed, they are held responsible till they have settled the bill, and ordered them discontinued.

If subscribers move to other places without informing the editor, they are held responsible till to the full payment of their account.

The Courts have decided that refusing to take periodicals from the office, or removing and leaving them uncanceled, is prima facie evidence of intentional fraud.
