AQUEDUCT TUNNELS GOOD.

Three Members of Board of Investigators Return from Trip Along the Line—To Compile Results.

Three members of the Aqueduct Investigation Board—C. E. Warner, chairman; E. C. Cady, and H. A. Hart—returned yesterday afternoon from a two weeks' automobile trip along the line. They were accompanied by Consulting Engineer D. E. Shafter and Attorney E. W. Euttle.

The party made the trip in two machines investigating conditions and other details which have been included in the investigation as outlined in the initiative ordinance adopted May 28 at special election. The investigators traveled 825 miles and devoted special attention to the concrete and tunnel work and the Chairman Long Valley reservoir. Warner declared that they found the tunnel work satisfactory and there were few complaints regarding the food served by Contractor Desmond.

The five members of the board, including Edward Johnson and E. S. Cobb, who did not accompany the other members on the recent trip, will meet Monday morning to compile results of this investigation.
